In cases where there was no clear choice among those present, we present the alternatives and leave it to the reader to decide how to vote. ***Not authorized by any candidate or candidate's committee.***

**U.S. Senate:** Three good candidates all running to unseat Dianne Feinstein, below is a summary of each candidate's key issues:

- Kevin De Leon: Supports Medicare for All, authored many of California's renewable energy and environmental protection regulations while a state senator, authored the "sanctuary state" bill
- David Hildebrand: Running as a Democratic Socialist. Supports Universal Healthcare, Labor Unions, and Police Reform
- Alison Hartson: Supports Medicare for All, Fight for \$15, and ending corporate money in politics

**YES: Prop 68:** Authorizes bonds funding for parks, natural resource protection, and other conservation efforts

**YES: Prop 69:** Requires specified transportation revenues be used for transportation purposes

**NO: Prop 70:** Requires supermajority vote approving cap-and-trade reserve fund

**YES: Prop 71:** Sets effective date for ballot measures meaning all votes will be counted

**YES: Prop 72:** Permits newly constructed rain-capture systems be excluded from property tax reassessments
